

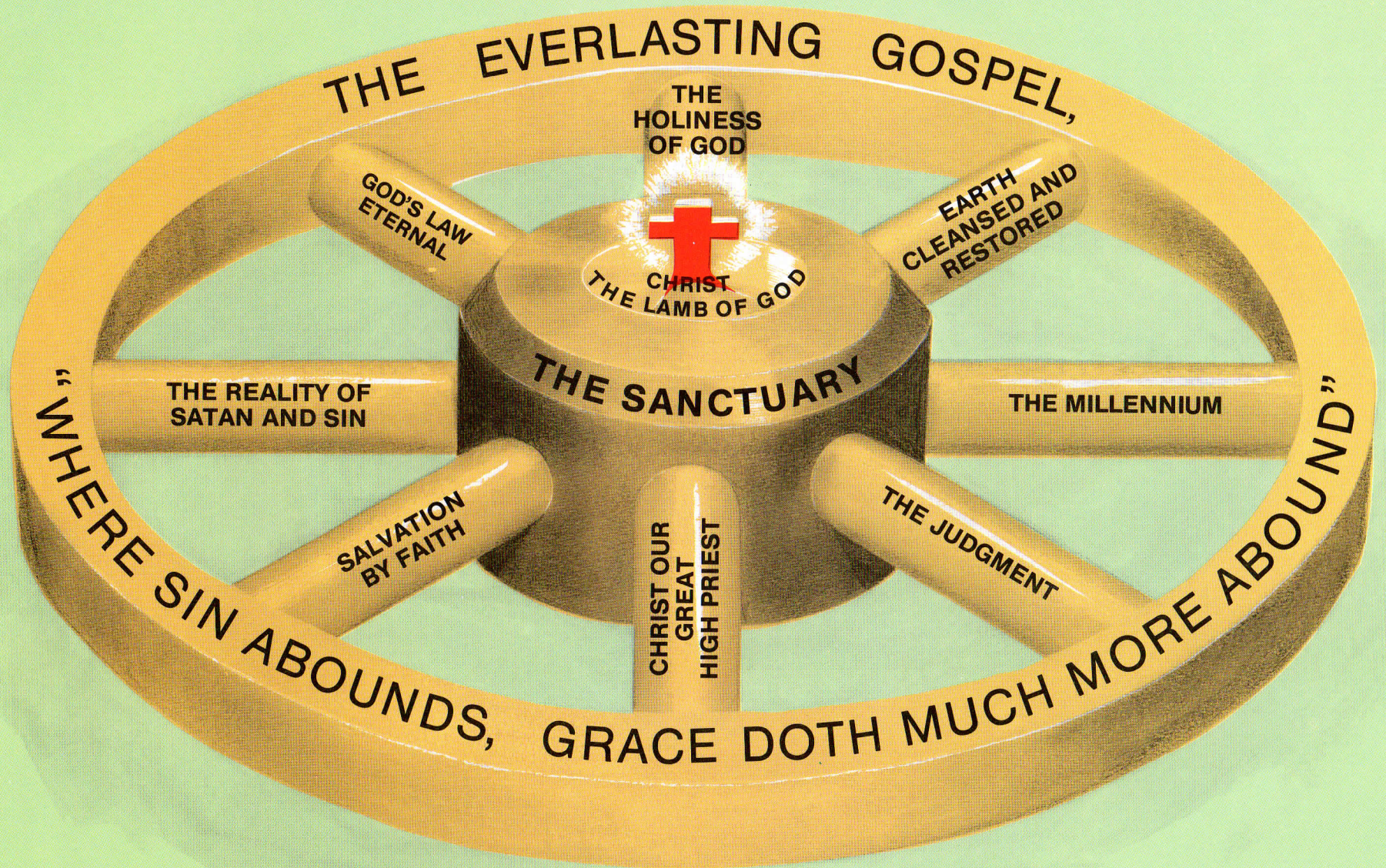

| 1 | * Genesis 2:1-3 | God rested. He sanctified it [set it apart for a holy use]. |
| 2 | * Exodus 20:8-11 | The Fourth Commandment |
| 3 | * Revelation 1:10 | There is a "Lord's Day" [Kuriake hemera]. This is the only place this Greek phrase is mentioned in all of scripture. The word <u>on</u> is from the Greek 'ev (en) - it never means about or concerning. This text therefore cannot possibly be referring to the "Day of the Lord" (Christ's second coming), but must be referring only to a special day referred to by John as the Lord's Day. |
| 4 | * Mark 2:27-28 | Jesus is Lord of it. When and for whom was the Sabbath made? It was made for man at the creation of the world. |
| 5 | * Colossians 1:12-21 | Everything was made by Jesus. |
| 6 | Ecclesiastes 3:14 | Whatever God does stands forever; nothing added or subtracted. |
| 7 | * Luke 4:16 | Jesus had a habit of going to the synagogue on the Sabbath. |
| 8 | Matthew 12:10-13 | It is lawful to do well on the Sabbath. |
| 9 | * Luke 23:54-56; | The preparation day, the Sabbath, and the first day of the |
| | * 24:1-3 | week follow in Bible order. |
| 10 | Leviticus 23 (All) | The seven ceremonial Sabbaths were distinctly separate from the Seventh-day sabbath. |
| 11 | * Genesis 1:5 | The evening and the morning make up a day. |
| 12 | * Deuteronomy 16:6 | At even, at the going down of the sun... |
| 13 | * Mark 13:35 | Even is different from midnight, cockcrowing, or morning. Pope Alexandria III changed daily reckoning to midnight. This was not accepted by the Protestant world for over 100 years. |
| 14 | * Exodus 16:4-5 | The manna proved the people concerning the Sabbath commandment. |
| 15 | * Exodus 16:22-28 | "How long refuse ye to keep My Commandments and My Laws?" |
| 16 | * Exodus 31:16-17 | The Sabbath is a sign between God and His children perpetually. |
| 17 | * Galatians 3:29 | If ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. |
| 18 | * Romans 2:28-29 | He is a Jew which is one inwardly, in the heart. |
| 19 | Genesis 26:5 | Abraham kept God's Law. |
| 20 | * Matthew 21:37-43 | "The kingdom of God shall be taken from you [the Jewish nation], and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof." |
| 21 | * Isaiah 56:2,6-7 | The Sabbath was made for everyone who joined with God. |
| 22 | Ecclesiastes 12:13 | Fear God, and keep His commandments. This is the whole duty of man. |
| 23 | * Ezekiel 20:19-20 | The Sabbath day is a sign between God and His people. |
| 24 | * Ezekiel 20:12 | The Sabbath is a sign of sanctification. |
| 25 | * Isaiah 58:12-14 | Turn away your foot from trampling on the Sabbath. |
| 26 | * Hebrews 10:24-25 | Not forsaking the assembly... |
| 27 | * Matthew 24:20 | Jesus told disciples to pray... |
| 28 | * Isaiah 66:23 | Sabbath kept in new earth... |
| 29 | * John 15:10 | "I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love." |
| 30 | * I John 2:3-6 | "He that saith he abideth in Him ought himself also so to walk, even as He walked." |
| 31 | Hebrews 13:8 | Jesus never changes. |

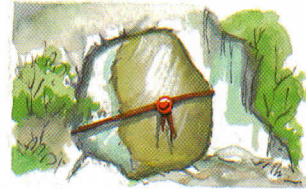

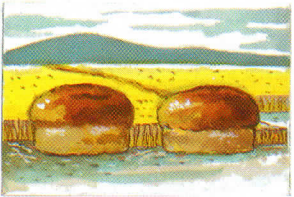

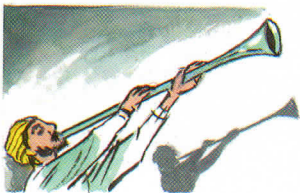
