THE SANCTUARY IN HEBREWS

Hebrews 6:19	"within the veil" -- Both the entrance of the Holy Place and the entrance of the Holy of Holies had veils. [See Hebrews 9:3 - the second veil was the entrance to the Holy of Holies]

Hebrews 8:2	"sanctuary"	-- Hagion	Sanctuary
Hebrews 9:1	"sanctuary"	-- Hagion	Sanctuary
Hebrews 9:2	"sanctuary"	-- Hagia	Holy Place
Hebrews 9:3	"holiest of all"	-- Hagia Hagion	Holy of Holies
Hebrews 9:8	"holiest of all" -- Hagion Sanctuary In Hebrews 9:1, Hagion is translated "sanctuary". The High Priest made his way into the Holiest of All every year (Hebrews 9:7) while the first tabernacle was yet standing. Then what was not yet made manifest? -- the way into the <u>Heavenly</u> Sanctuary. This word Hagion always must be translated "sanctuary" (not "holiest of all") in order to make good sense.		
Hebrews 9:12	"holy place"	-- Hagia	Holy Place (See Hebrews 9:2)
Hebrews 9:24	"holy places"	-- Hagia	Holy Place
Hebrews 9:25	"holy place"	-- Hagia	Holy Place
Hebrews 10:19	"holiest"	-- Hagion	Sanctuary (See Hebrews 9:1)
Hebrews 10:20	"through the veil"-- See Hebrews 6:19 -- the Holy Place had an entrance veil called the first veil. See Hebrews 9:3 -- The second veil was the entrance to the Holy of Holies.		
Hebrews 13:11	"sanctuary" -- Hagia Holy Place A reading of these scriptures pictures Christ as entering into the first compartment of the sanctuary to make intercession for us. Other scriptures picture him as seated at the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19).
